
NEW ROC PUBLICATION IS NOW AVAILABLE

In addition to the general history of the organisation and Home Office/UKWMO this book covers proposed developments post 1991, the Nuclear Reporting Cells and ROC involvement in aircraft tracking 1976 - 1992.
