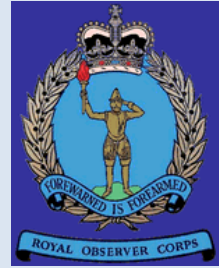




Ronald Richmond Glover 1925 – 2016



1941 One of the first members of the Air Training Corps (previously the ADDC)

1942 Volunteered and was accepted by the Royal Air Force for pilot training and was awarded the Pilot's brevet on completion in Southern Rhodesia.

Selected for the Central Flying School Course at RAF Norton. Qualified as Flying Instructor, engaged on these duties in Southern Rhodesia until November 1945.

1948 Released from the RAF and passed the Civil Service Commissioners selection board.

1954 Appointed a Whole time officer in the Royal Observer Corps

1960 Following 2 tours as a Group Training Officer was posted to RAF Bentley Priory for Operations Staff duties.

1961 Promoted to rank of Observer Lieutenant Commander

1967 Promoted to rank of Observer Commander

1972 The first officer to be appointed to the uniformed post of Senior Administration Officer at HQ ROC

1978 Awarded the ROC medal

1981 Held the appointment of Deputy Area Commandant in the Metropolitan area

1985 Retired from the ROC having served at Bentley Priory for almost 18 years of a career spanning 31 years.
