# BATTLE OF BRITAIN 80 ANNIVERSARY COMMEMORATION SERVICE Message from the RAF Ceremonial Team

The RAF Ceremonial team would like to thank you for your patience with regard to the planning of the Service at Westminster Abbey on 20th September to commemorate the 80th Anniversary of the Battle of Britain.

Regrettably, due to COVID-19 and in line with the guidance issued by the Government and the clergy of Westminster Abbey, we are unable to issue you with tickets this year.

There is to be a 'symbolic' Service in the Abbey to mark this very important occasion, however, this will be with very limited numbers; a carefully chosen congregation will consist of representatives for a cross-section of all those traditionally attending. Unfortunately, we do not expect that this Service will be televised.

I am sure you will share our sadness that we cannot conduct the Service in the usual way this year, but hope that you will fully understand the circumstances for this. Hopefully, we can look forward to welcoming you to the Battle of Britain Service next year.

We recognise the opportunity we now have as a result of a possible change, to place the 'spotlight' onto veterans in a unique way this year. We would like to ask if any members of your association are, or indeed know of, any Veterans who served in any capacity with the RAF during the Battle of Britain or World War II. In particular, veterans who have a connection to any personnel currently serving, who would be willing to possibly give an interview possibly to the BBC in aid of the Battle of Britain 80th Anniversary Commemoration.

WWII veterans may still be required we will be in contact with those who have responded with more information on this matter in due course.

ROCA Members who served or know of a Veteran who served in the ROC during WW11 please contact either Tim Kitching or me if you are willing to give an interview as requested above.

## The latest from The Royal British Legion on the planning and issue of tickets is as follows:

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, we are continually reviewing our events and to ensure better clarity on the situation in November, the Legion will communicate its full plans for this year's Cenotaph in early autumn.

Please note the Legion is working closely with all the relevant Government agencies to ensure that this year's Cenotaph Dispersal can go ahead in some form. A range of representative options are under consideration by the Government. We will keep you informed as and when plans progress.

For Associations expecting to hear confirmation of their allocations, please note that we will be deferring this until we have some clearer guidance from the Government.
