There is dis-abled access and lifts to all floors. The hotel is near the rail station and there is parking at the hotel. High street local shops and a short walk the sea can sometimes been seen. For those who will join us for the first time the following is the weekend events with plenty of time after the formalities to meet up, relax and chat with ROC friends.

Friday- After booking in at the main reception please go to the ROCA reception table where Chairman John Sharpe will meet you and hand out the weekend programme. The hotel will provide complimentary tea and coffee. In the evening after dinner John Sharpe will welcome and open the weekend. **The raffle, donation of prizes from Group and individuals' hand to Gordon Johnson in reception on arrival.**Saturday – Morning the Annual Delegates Meeting (ADM) that will finish by 1230. The evening Gala Dinner at which our President will once again entertain us with his tales and the opportunity to chat to Cliff when he circulates the tables during the evening.

Friday and Saturday evenings the Heritage team will be on hand to help with any heritage questions and show what they can do on your behalf. I will be selling ROCA Merchandise details of some items can be viewed on the website and pre-ordered. Jenny Major will sell her cards and Cheryl Stewart with her memorabilia in aid of Arbroath Post.

Important Note on cancellations - All cancellations must be notified to John Sharpe. Any cancellations made after 30th September the hotel will charge you for 1 night. If you cancel prior to 30th September, you will not be charged but forfeit your £30 non-refundable deposit.

If you have not cancelled but do not turn up on the 1st day you have booked, you will be charged 1 night.

Annual Delegates Meeting – Saturday morning 14th October at 10am. A room available with the capacity to seat all of us who wish to attend. Either Air Commodore Simon Harper OBE MA Chartered FCIPD who is the new Director of Grants, Services & Programmes or Neil Sturtridge or a representative from the RAF Benevolent Fund will update us on the ROC and RAF Benevolent Funds.

The National Committee recommends the annual capitation paid by Groups for the running of the organisation is increased to £3. The annual fee pays for the website, PLI, postage, liaison, participation in national events, and most importantly our preservation and all the work of the National Heritage team.

The Resolution is with Group Secretaries and Area Reps to consult with all members for their decision on its acceptance. Group Delegates to be notified prior to the meeting on the Group's majority decision. To be accepted the resolution requires a 2/3rds majority in accordance with the Constitution.

In setting this small increase of £1 the National Committee is mindful that many Groups have not increased their subscription for some years and have declining membership. With annual increasing costs, Groups need to consider if it is now prudent to increase their subscriptions to prepare to meet future capitation increases to sustain a viable National organisation.

ROCA Beret badge – The decision made in January that non-serving members wore a beret without a badge gave rise to a diverse exchange of opinions and views. The National Committee at their meeting on 17th June took account of all the opinions and the majority view that a beret with no badge was inappropriate. It was decided that a beret size ROCA badge will be purchased and paid for from the national fund. It is hoped that a supply will be available for purchase by members at the Reunion.

There was discussion on the view expressed by a few that non-serving members could be given the option not to wear a beret. It was pointed out that some other contingents on Parade do allow bare heads. The Committee majority view was for Group events the Group committee could decide that non-serving members should they wish to be allowed not to wear a beret but on National Parades the dress code should be:

- (i) National Parades All ex serving ROC to wear the beret and ROC badge, non-serving members to wear the beret with the ROCA badge.
- (ii) Local Parades the Group to have discretion if members could march bare headed.

It was decided to ask the Groups to obtain their members views on acceptance of the above policy. Group secretaries please instruct Delegates to vote at the ADM to either accept or decline that on National Parades berets to be worn with the appropriate badge and that Groups to decide for their local events. This will be a straight majority decision.

Battle of Britain Service Westminster Abbey 17th September – Please apply with your name and address by 8th July. The National Standard will be Paraded. Apply to me if you are available to carry your Group Standard, no marching involved.

Capel Le Ferne Memorial Service – In July Terry and Jackie Giles will represent us at the service.

RIAT July 2023 – If you are attending the show, visit the National Heritage display in the Village Green.
