

**Obs Cdr Harry Teaque** ~ I am told at his Funeral in total there were 26 ROCA members present with approx. 14 in the guard of honour that included Seaborne Don Marsh. The following is part of Margaret Baynton's tribute to Harry:

'Harry joined the Royal Observer Corps in 1955 and first served in 8 Group Coventry where he attained the rank of Observer Officer.

He moved to Norfolk in 1967 and for a short time was Post Instructor on 22 Post Aylsham which I have only just found out - as I was also Post Instructor on Aylsham Post in 1987! Soon afterwards Harry took on the role of Post Controller on Crew 3 at Group Control and in 1970 he was appointed Group Commandant, a role he held until his retirement in 1989. He was one of the longest serving Senior (sparetime) Officers and was highly respected by all his peers. In 1987 Harry was awarded the MBE for services to the Royal Observer Corps of which he was justly proud. In 1986 the 6 Group Royal Observer Corps Association was formed and Harry became Chairman until he vacated that position and was elected President in 2013.'

**Obs Lt Cdr Geoff Paine** ~ Born 26 May 1925 sadly passed away 29 August 2019. Geoff was the 1st National Secretary of ROCA. His full Obituary by Lawrence Holmes is on the ROCA web site.
