In the 17 November 2017 Snippets front page news for all members reported on the Official and the press release of the Royal Observer Corps Benevolent Fund to the hand over of the reins to the RAF Benevolent Fund. The Official hand -over ceremony held at Bentley Priory. The announcement prior to launch was also made to all Delegates at the ROCA National Reunion ADM in October 2017. There is a link on the ROCA web site and the above banner to provide full contact details appears in every edition of the majority of Group newsletters. It therefore amazes me that I continue to receive emails and questions at a number of Group meetings AGMs that I attend that members do not know how to make enquiries nor contact with the RAFBF and are unaware of the hand over.

The RAF Benevolent Fund is the RAF's leading welfare charity providing financial practical and emotional support to serving and former members of the RAF, as well as their partners and dependants. They help members of the RAF family with everything from disability, injury, financial hardship and youth support to living independently and to provide dignity in retirement.

The press released published at the time of launch announced that the ROCBF will be absorbed in to the administrative care of the RAF's leading welfare charity. The merging of the two charities builds on the close relationship and excellent partnerships developed over several years. The full press release was sent to Group Secretaries and Editors. It was available on the ROCA/ROCBF/RAFBF web sites.

All Groups are required to have an appointed ROCABFLO. Their role shifted from one of handling applications to welfare and publishing the wider benefits now available. As a separate attachment I will send the changed role instructions issued at the time.
